Call for Applications for awards for 2017-2018 academic year

Purpose of the award:

- To support adult women students who are pursuing their academic goals.
- To reduce the student's amount of loan, work study, or personal/family contribution, and not reduce any college or university grant. The award will equal the cost of tuition and fees for one or more courses up to a maximum of \$4,000, depending upon the institution attended.

Who may apply:

A candidate must be:

- female, age 24 or above
- resident of one of the 29 towns served by the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving:

- matriculated in 2017-2018 as an undergraduate pursuing an AA or a BA/BS degree at one of the following colleges or universities:

- enrolled either on a part-time or full-time basis
- have a GPA of 2.5 or above
- have completed 15 hours or the equivalent of academic work
- eligible for financial assistance as determined by the federal Student Aid Report (SAR) and by submission of your 2016 federal tax return

Criteria for evaluation:

Academic record, application essay, faculty recommendation, and financial need are considered in choosing the recipients. An interview is required.

A completed application must include TWO copies of:

- completed Town and County Club application form
- unofficial transcripts from ALL colleges attended within the last **five** years
- copy of all pages of your federal Student Aid Report (SAR)
- copy of your 2016 federal tax return
- reference from a faculty member with whom you have had at least one course
- personal statement answering questions given on application (*see IV. on application*)

Applications must be received by February 24, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. by the Scholarship Committee of the Town and County Club, 22 Woodland Street, Hartford, CT 06105.

Decisions: Applicants will be notified after May 1, 2017. Awards are for 2017-18 academic year.
